-EMS Legacy and traditions, new and old to share with the Mariner families.

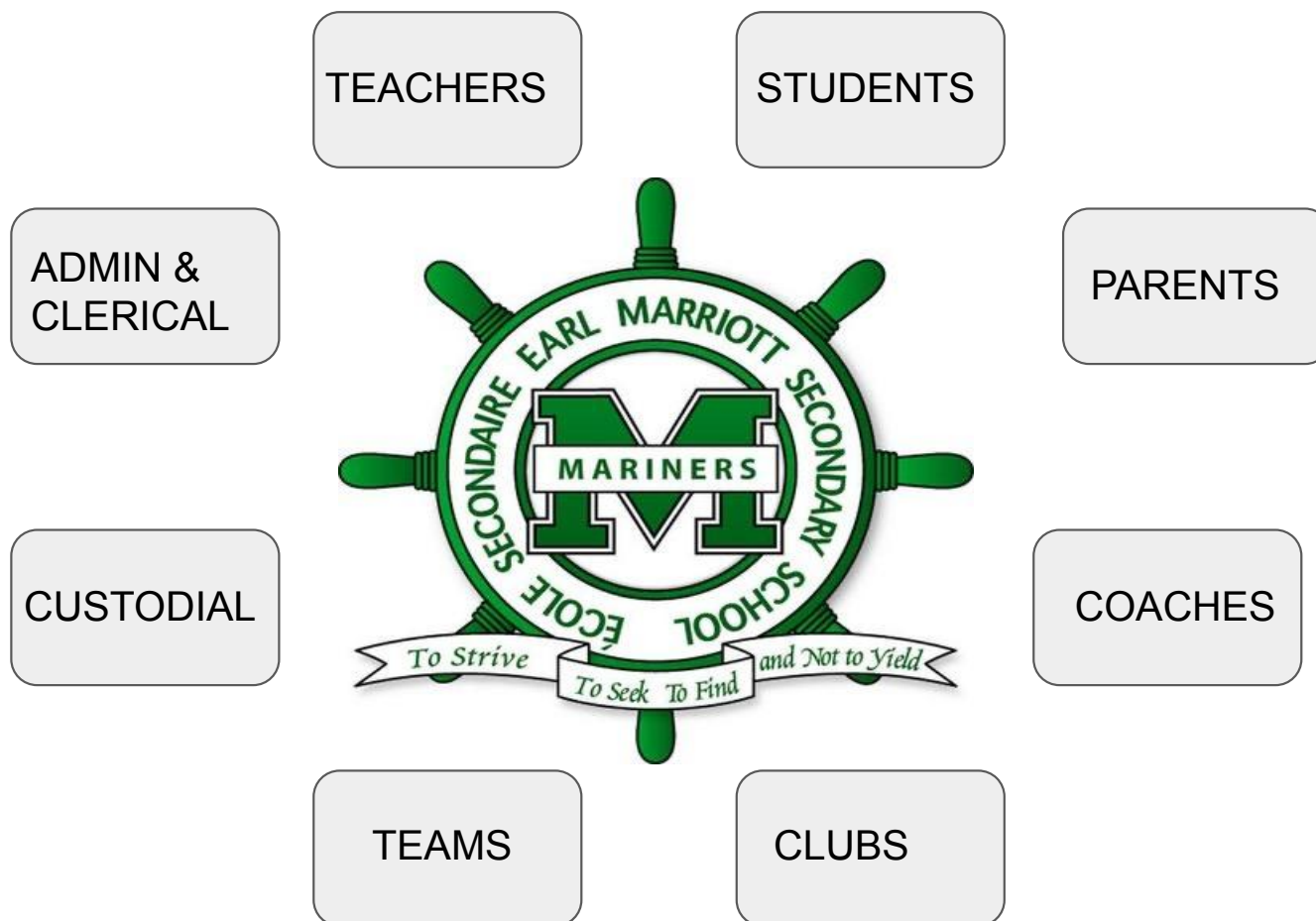
